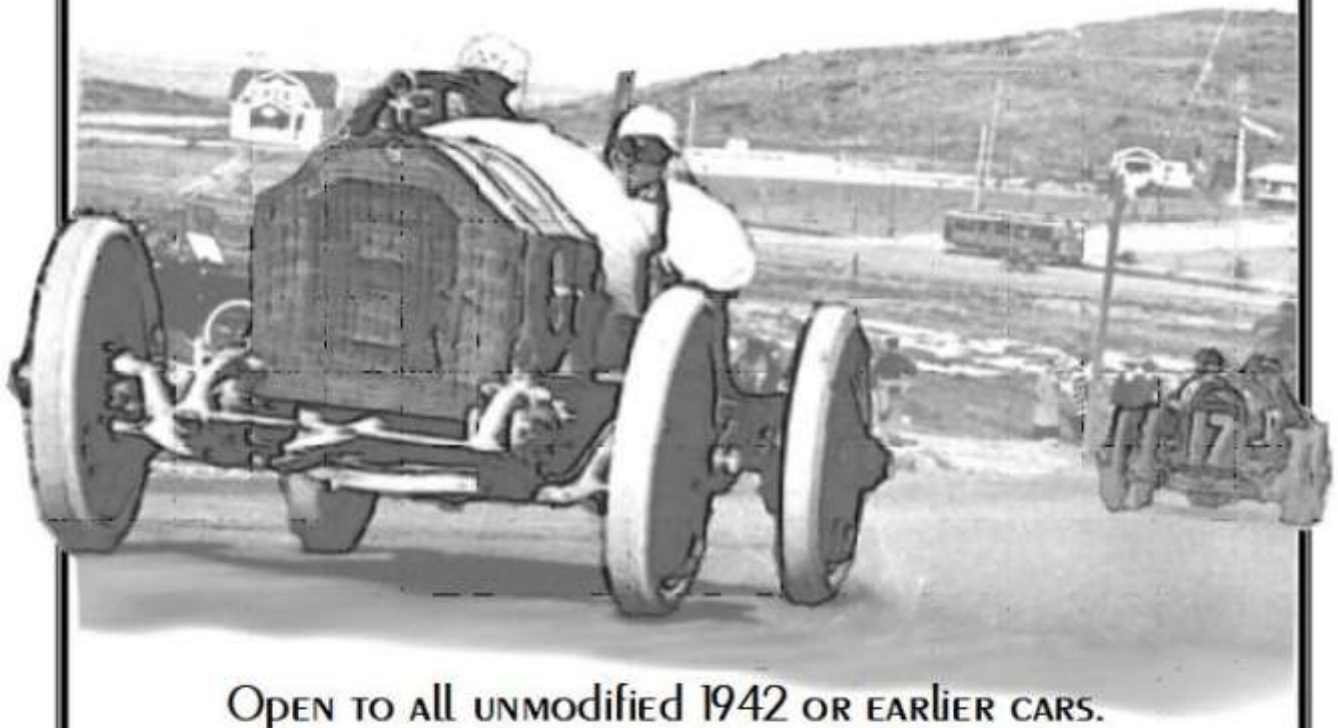

The event will begin with a Thursday afternoon, October 16, 2025 arrival and check-in at the Pala Mesa Resort (2001 Old Hwy 395, Fallbrook, Ca.
